Sam died on November 27, 2021 at 75 years old in Centennial, Colorado.

Christine Powers McGloughlin, in her tribute to Sam in his obituary, indicates that Sam was in the Silent Service, Navy submarine force, at one time. Sam later went to tech school and continued his career in construction and repair. He worked in drywall and was proficient in all construction trades. He later worked for Oakwood Homes in the Denver area as a warranty representative. He loved history and was well versed with world history/current events, construction and outdoor activities. He loved war movies and sci-fi movies, cats and dogs, cooking, and was an easy laugh. Also, Sam was a hunter, loved fishing and camping and the outdoors and was well loved by many.
